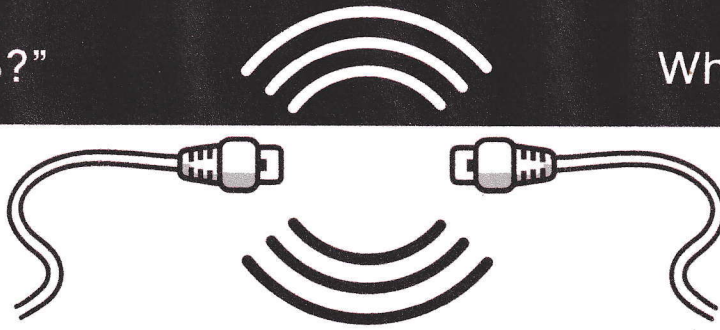


What is "CAT6?"
